Journey to the Wild

Fall Elk Bugling, Wolves & Bears Expedition

Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks

3 Days/2 Nights

\$1,450/person \$125 Single Traveler Supplement

This popular expedition focuses on Greater Yellowstone's predators. The Lamar and Hayden Valleys, where bears hunt, are the same areas where the wolves den, centralizing predator activity. Participants travel to the best sites for viewing bears and wolves. In addition, the trip includes stops at Old Faithful and the colorful Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone - crowned by a waterfall nearly twice the height of Niagara Falls.

Itinerary

Day 1: Your Expedition begins at 6:00am in the lobby of your chosen accommodation in Jackson, Wyoming. Participants should arrive with packed personal items for a two nights stay. We journey north through dramatic Grand Teton National Park. Grand Teton National Park is home to one of the largest elk herds in North America. We will search for moose and bears along the prime riparian habitats of Jackson Hole. Following a mid-morning brunch we head into Yellowstone National Park, the world's first National Park. The midday hours will be spent exploring the geothermal basin near Old Faithful. After seeing the famous geyser erupt, we continue north to Mammoth Hot Springs. Our safari continues in the scenic Lamar Valley in search of bears and wolves, enjoying a light field dinner en route. We spend the twilight hours continuing our search: a successful expedition depends almost entirely upon searching key areas during these evening hours. After dark, we drive to our accommodations in Cooke City, Montana.

Overnight: Alpine Motel, Cooke City, Montana

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 2: We return to the Lamar Valley, called America's Serengeti, in hopes of witnessing the morning hunt. A light field breakfast will be provided. Mid-day will provide an opportunity to explore the predators' habitat on foot. We continue to search for bison, pronghorn and coyotes to name a few species we might encounter. The high elevation snow and lush valley's create a phenomenon of high bear densities, we have the chance of encountering both Grizzly and Black bears. After dark, we will return to Cooke City for the night.

Overnight: Alpine Motel, Cooke City, Montana

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 3: After swinging through Lamar Valley for one last look, we will leave this area mid-morning to enjoy a hearty lunch. Afterwards, we will tour Hayden Valley, favored habitat for grizzly bears. Our return trip may include stops at the colorful Grand Canyon of Yellowstone, crowned by a waterfall more than twice the height of Niagara Falls. We will return to your chosen accommodation in Jackson, arriving in the early evening.

Overnight: Jackson, Wyoming (not included)

Meals: Breakfast and Lunch

Inclusions: Services of Wildlife Expeditions Biologist, transportation in a Safari-style vehicle, use of high quality binoculars and spotting scopes, all meals as stated, National Park Service entrance fee, gratuities at restaurants

Exclusions: Airfare to and from Jackson Hole, alcoholic beverages, phone calls, gratuities for biologist, other items of personal nature.
