

Teton Valley Community School offers tuition assistance workshop

Do you think you can't afford an independent school education for your child? You can at the Teton Valley Community School of Teton Science Schools! On Thursday, February 21st at 5:30 p.m., Teton Valley Community School (TVCS) will be hosting a Tuition Assistance Workshop for local families interested in learning more about an affordable independent school option. The workshop will be held on the TVCS campus at 192 West Birch Street in Victor. Free childcare will be available.

TVCS consistently raises and allocates nearly \$50,000 per academic year to support families that are unable to pay the full tuition, which is \$7,195 for a full-time student attending TVCS this year. Fifty-two percent of the students that currently attend TVCS's elementary program (K-6th) receive tuition assistance. Awards

range from \$750 to \$3,500 per student and are based strictly on financial need.

TVCS offers preschool through sixth grade students a diverse and dynamic learning environment. In addition to providing an exceptional academic program, learning at TVCS includes artistic and musical expression, healthy social and emotional development, and physical activity and coordination. Enrichment classes and field trips compliment the school's unique project-based curriculum, in which students explore real-world questions and challenges, while simultaneously developing critical thinking and interpersonal skills. Full day, project-based preschool and Kindergarten programs are also available at TVCS with extended care until 5:30 p.m. every day. For more information call TVCS at 208-787-0445.
