




# Fall Wolf & Bear Tour

PREDATORS OF GREATER YELLOWSTONE



3 DAYS, 2 NIGHTS • \$1,450/PERSON, \$125 SINGLE SUPPLEMENT FEE

*This popular tour focuses on Greater Yellowstone's predators. The Lamar and Hayden Valleys, where bears hunt, are the same areas where the wolves den, centralizing predator activity. You will travel to the best sites for viewing bears and wolves. In addition, the trip includes stops at Old Faithful and the colorful Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone- crowned by a waterfall nearly twice the height of Niagara Falls.*



## Day 1: Grand Teton & Yellowstone National Parks

Your expedition begins at 6:00 AM in the lobby of your chosen accommodation in Jackson, Wyoming. You should arrive to the lobby with packed personal items for two nights. From the town of Jackson, WY, you will journey north through Grand Teton National Park. Along the drive you will search for moose, elk and bears along riparian, sagebrush, and conifer habitats. Following a mid-morning brunch you will head into Yellowstone National Park—the world's first National Park. The mid day hours will be spent exploring the geothermal basin near Old Faithful. After seeing the famous geyser erupt, you will continue further north to the scenic Lamar Valley. While observing wildlife you will enjoy a light field dinner. The twilight hours will be spent continuing your search for wildlife before driving to Cooke City, MT where you will stay for the night.

### Day 2: Lamar Valley

In the early morning you will return to the Lamar Valley, famed as "America's Serengeti." A light field breakfast will be provided while you listen for bugling elk and search for bears. Mid day will offer a chance to explore the ecosystem on foot while hiking. While hiking, you'll have a chance to search for tracks and other signs of wildlife. During the afternoon and evening you will continue to search for and observe wildlife via our customized Mercedes-Benz Sprinter vans. After dark you will return to Cooke City for dinner and then rest up for your final day.

### Day 3: Hayden Valley

You'll depart Cooke City in the early morning and swing through the Lamar Valley one last time to search for bears, wolves and other wildlife. Afterwards, you will tour Hayden Valley, favored habitat for grizzly bears and bison. Your return trip may include stops at the colorful Grand Canyon of Yellowstone, crowned by a waterfall more than twice the height of Niagara Falls. You'll return to Jackson in the early evening. Your guide will drop you off at your lodging accommodation and bid you farewell.

 **Overnight:** Jackson, WY (not included)
