



Winter Wildlife & Wolves in Yellowstone

JACKSON HOLE, WY TO BOZEMAN, MT



Day 1: Welcome to Jackson Hole!

Upon arriving to Jackson, Wyoming you'll check in to the Lexington Hotel. At 5:45 PM you'll meet your guide and fellow travelers in the main lobby of the Lexington Hotel. Together you'll travel to the famous Wort Hotel where you will have dinner and receive a thorough orientation. During the orientation your guide will go over the itinerary in detail and they will describe what you should expect to experience during the tour. You will also have the chance to ask many questions. Following dinner you will be transported back to the Lexington Hotel in one of our customized Mercedes-Benz Sprinter vans.

Day 2: Grand Teton National Park, Art & Sleigh

You'll officially begin your tour with a morning of wildlife watching in Grand Teton National Park. During mid-day you'll have lunch at a local restaurant and enjoy a docent-led tour of the National Museum of Wildlife Art. In the afternoon you'll go on private, horse-drawn sleigh ride on the National Elk Refuge. During the sleigh ride you'll get to observe wild elk up close. In the evening you will be free to explore downtown Jackson. Dinner will be on your own.

Day 3 : Travel to Yellowstone

This morning you'll continue seeking and observing wildlife as you head north through Grand Teton National Park toward Yellowstone—America's first National Park. At the South Entrance of Yellowstone you will transition from a wheeled-vehicle into our custom Mercedes-Benz snowcoaches. From there you will embark on the Yellowstone portion of the tour. In the afternoon you will visit Old Faithful as well as other geothermal features. Dinner will take place in the Old Faithful Snow Lodge.

Day 4: Northern Range

On this day you will travel from Old Faithful to Mammoth Hot Springs via snowcoach. After exploring the geothermal features of Mammoth Hot Springs you will transition into a wheeled vehicle and drive to Cooke City, Montana. Along the way you will have a chance to search for wildlife in the Lamar Valley, famed as "America's serengeti."

Day 5: Northern Range of Yellowstone

You will spend this day searching northern Yellowstone for wild wolves. Lamar Valley is famous for its wolves but you will also have the opportunity to see golden eagles, coyotes, bighorn sheep, foxes, bison and possibly moose. During part of the day you'll have a chance to explore the Lamar Valley via snowshoe. In the afternoon, you'll visit with local photographer Dan Hartman. Dan will give a private presentation on the wildlife of the region and give you a tour of his gallery. The day will end with one last chance to spot wildlife before having dinner back in Cooke City.

 **Overnight:** High Country Motel and Cabins, Cooke City, MT

Day 6: Lamar Valley, Paradise Valley, and Bozeman

This will be the final day of the tour. The morning hours will be spent searching for wildlife in Lamar Valley. After eating lunch near Mammoth Hot Springs you will depart for Bozeman, Montana. Along the way to Bozeman you will stop to search for wildlife in Paradise Valley. In the evening you'll celebrate the tour with your fellow travelers and your guide as you share a farewell dinner.
